Pollution Prevention:

- ◆ **NEVER dump anything into a street, gutter or storm drain.**
- ◆ Plant a rain garden.
- ◆ **Do not wash vehicles on paved surfaces.**
- ◆ Eliminate/reduce your use of pesticides, herbicides, salt and fertilizer.
- ◆ **Sweep leaves and grass clippings away from sidewalks, streets, and driveways.**
- ◆ Plant native vegetation buffers if you live along a shoreline.
- ◆ Fix leaks on your vehicles.
- ◆ **Pick up after your pets; dispose of waste in the trash.**
- ◆ Only place leaves on streets during designated fall leaf pickup dates.
- ◆ Bring leftover toxic material to a waste collection facility:
