### **Acceptable Items**

#### **Food Scraps**

- Vegetable & fruit peels
- Meat trimmings & bones
- · Grains, breads, & egg shells
- Dairy products
- Coffee filters & grounds
- Leftovers

## **Food Soiled Paper Products**

- · Napkins and paper towels
- Greasy pizza delivery boxes
- BPI certified compostable plates, cups, bowls, utensils, etc.

#### Yard waste

- Grass & leaves
- Garden waste
- Sticks and twigs no bigger than the width of a pencil

# Can I bag my organics?

Only in a BPI certified compostable bag, brown paper bag or no bag at all. **No** plastic bags.

#### Acceptable Items

- Cardboard boxes (flatten)
- Mail & paper
- Newspaper & magazines
- Food and beverage boxes (Cereal, pop, pasta, etc.)
- Plastic containers (#1, 2, & 5)
- · Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum & tin cans
- Shipping and packing paper
- Cartons (Milk, juice, etc.)

# Do labels or caps need to be removed?

No.

#### Can I bag my recyclables?

No, put them in your cart loose. Bagged recyclables are treated as contamination and will not be recycled.

# Acceptable Items (Items that should NEVER be put in organics or recycling)

- · Plastic bags and film
- Personal care products, diapers, & wipes
- Pet waste, litter, and bedding
- Wrappers from chips, candy, condiments & foil drink/snack pouches
- Non-recyclable plastic and plastic lined paper
  - Decorative paper plates, cups, to-go containers, straws and utensils
- Durable items
  - Non-usable clothing and shoes
  - Large plastic items like storage tubs
  - Kids toys
  - Garden hoses and window blinds
- Any products labeled "Biodegradable"
