SUMMARY A SEASONAL POSITION THAT TEACHES GROUPS AND INDIVIDUALS OF VARYING AGES SWIMMING AND WATER SAFETY SKILLS WHILE ENSURING THE SAFETY OF PARTICIPANTS. ASSESSES AND PROVIDES FEEDBACK ON SWIMMERS ABILITIES AND HELPS PLACE THEM IN THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Teach/co-teach skills in accordance with PRCE swim lesson curriculum
- 2. Promote, teach and ensure the safety of all participants
- 3. Plan and organize class outlines, methods and goals based on the provided curriculum
- 4. Modify curriculum based on participant skill levels
- 5. Monitor participants during instruction and assess their progress
- 6. Complete progress reports as needed
- 7. Know, understand, consistently and impartially enforce safety rules, policies and guidelines for the pool
- 8. Attend all staff meetings and in-service trainings as scheduled
- 9. Other duties as assigned

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Report to work on time
- Wear required uniform
- Neat and clean appearance
- Ability to work with a diverse group of customers
- Maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and with the public
- Ability to make decisions in accordance with policies and procedures and in emergency situations
- Strong public relations skills
- Strong communication skills
- Perform all essential position functions under the working conditions as described
- While performing the duties of the job, the employee is regularly required to stand, talk, hear, swim, etc.
- Specific vision abilities required include close vision, distant vision and peripheral vision.
- Flexibility regarding scheduling and shift changes
- Must be 15 years of age or older

- Previous participation in aquatics programing (swim/dive team, swim lessons, etc.)

WORKING CONDITIONS

Seasonal temporary position. The swim lesson program is held approximately June through August. Variable hours with a rotating schedule up to 7 days per week including days, evenings, weekends and holidays. Inside work and outside work in all types of weather conditions.

Starting Pay \$15.28/hour
