The Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the Hutchinson City Council and makes recommendations on issues regarding public art within the city limits.

About the Sculpture Stroll

The Hutchinson Public Arts Commission created the Sculpture Stroll in 2013 as a way to showcase work from local, regional and national artists and to beautify public spaces. Hutchinson currently has twelve permanent sculptures, two historic murals and thirteen rotating sculptures that are leased from various artists for one year.

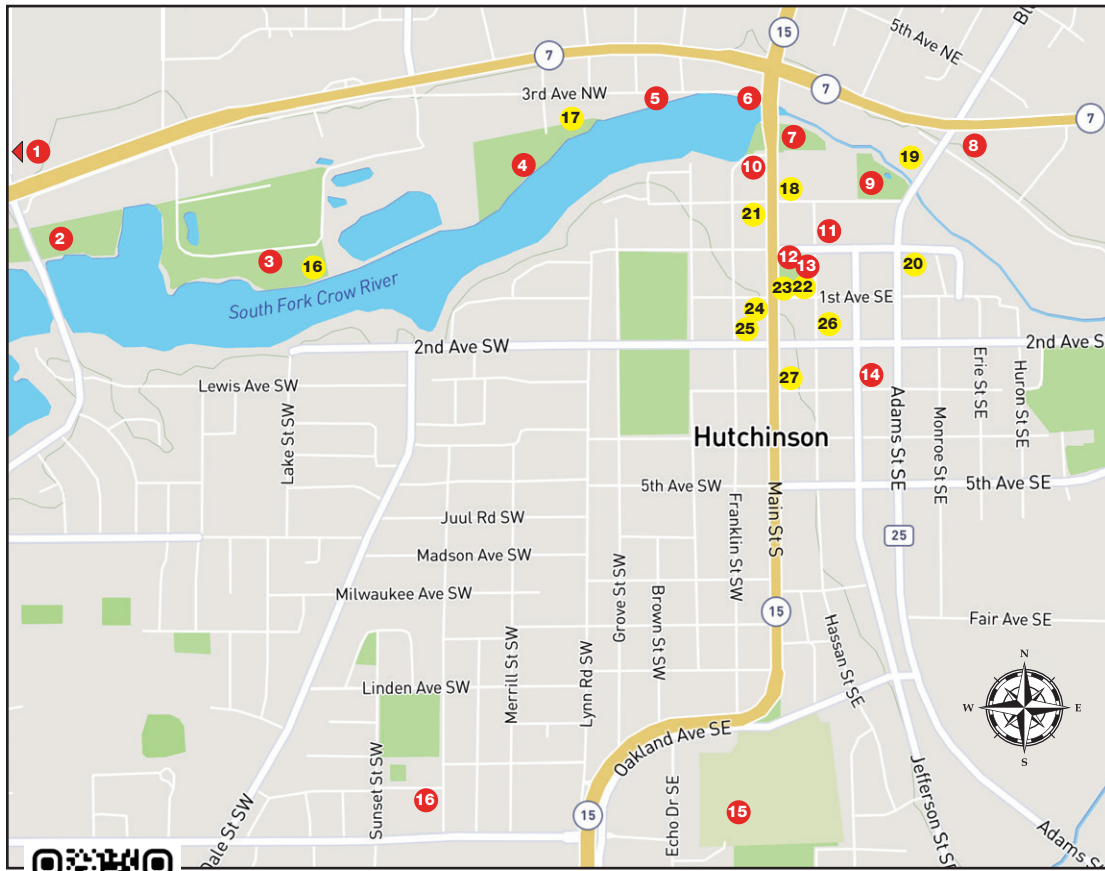
